# The End of Europe: Dictators, Demagogues, and the Coming Dark Age

Sponsored by the Savannah Council of World Affairs, James Kirchick summarized his latest book. He is a visiting fellow at the Brookings Institution in Washington, DC. After the fall of the Soviet Union in the 1990s, three basic assumptions that have now proven to be unwarranted: 1-Liberal democratic rule is uncontested and will dominate 2-Free market capitalism has been vindicated as the best economic program.

3-Perpetual peace will prevail as security is guaranteed. The first is refuted by new right-wing regimes in Hungary and Poland. The second by a resurgence of economic popularism and trade restrictions. The third by Russian aggression in the Ukraine and Crimea, and sabre rattling military exercises on eastern Europe's borders. Plus, massive migrations from the Middle East and Islamic terrorism are severely worrying populace of western Europe.

The risk to Europe is misunderstanding these forces and regressing to separate nation states paranoid over immigration and rejecting liberal democracy values that made Europe an economic success after World War II.

One theory is an energized Russia needs to combat NATO's expansion into former Soviet lands. In contrast, fear of Russian aggression may have motivated countries to join NATO, hoping Article 5 will deter Russian evasion. Also Trump's complaining about NATO's underfunding its military commitments may embolden Putin to try to expand into more countries, justifying invasion as protecting Russian nationals that happen to live in Estonia or Latvia.

Putin is not so motivated by communism - a clearly failed system. His former KGB training just encourages raw power expansion, using Russian military threats, and the disruptive capability of cyber terrorism. His goal is to undermine Western values, creating economic chaos. Russia even backed France's Marine Le Pen's candidacy, as ta clear rejection of traditional liberal democracy. An American in Russia also tried to create California chaos promoting its secession from the US. Russian also allegedly promoted Catalonian secession from Spain, and Britain's exit from the EU.

Allegedly Putin wanted Trump elected because of his disruptive tendencies and anti-EU rhetoric, yet Trump's actual policies after election were anti-Russian. Trump may be sowing tribalism in Europe by anti-immigration rhetoric, with an EU poll now showing most Europeans want a policy of no Muslin immigration to most EU countries.

European apathy now ignores its former strength as a bastion of liberal democracy. In France, only 20% supported the prior regime's policies, with a social democrat getting only 6% of the vote. President Macron was a maverick and political novice who managed to massively upset the status quo, in the first runoff election in over 50 years. It was conceded that France's structural unemployment rate of 10% has the electorate worried that former liberal policies just haven't worked by making it hard to fire anyone for incompetence or low productivity.

Other political fragmentation shows in Holland, the UK and Spain. so look at EU policies is in order. Greece cheated to get in, and their corruption is still unchecked.

Anti-Semitism is also on the rise, among liberals and conservatives, not just from a growing Muslim population. The latter's migration crisis caused an influx of two million new Muslims that have hot assimilated at all into traditional European culture. Right wing populism from that threat is not likely to subside, as there is more migration likely from continued unrest in both the Middle East and Africa. A recent poll among Europeans shows the two biggest issues as immigration and terrorism.

Trump's espousing of "America first" policies is not viewed as helping to maintain European economic strength. His shoot-from-the-hip tweets and his demands for changing the trade rules have clearly upset traditional western European politicians. They fear that a needed US pivot back to the old way of business in Europe is not very likely.

## **Q&A Session**

- What is Europe's view of the American pull-out from the Iran Nuclear Deal? Traditional Europeans thought that deal was well-constructed in deferring a nuclear Iran, while removing sanctions and allowing profitable trade to resume with Iran. Trump's tear up of the agreement was too easy, as Obama never submitted it for ratification in Congress. Trump's election was a surprise to Europe as it was to most people in Washington. Despite grumbling by some economic sources in Europe, no one dares defy the US, so the new and stronger sanctions will be very effective in motivating Iran to negotiate a new deal.
- Will NATO countries pony up more defense spending to meet their 2% commitments? Grudgingly yes for most, as they should. Every president has complained, but Trump seems to be the one actually getting results. The real question is whether Putin is emboldened by a Trump's questioning NATO and maybe Russia will be tempted to test NATO's resolve.
- In Germany, what was Merkel thinking when planning an oil pipeline to Russia? The rest of Europe other resents Germany's attempt to cut them out of the supply. Also, why would Germany's risk economic blackmail by depending so much on Russian energy? Kirchick attributed Germany's poor judgment to a pacifist tendency now and a guilt complex over their World War II record.
- Why did Russia poison its former KGB agent and his daughter in London? Basically, Putin is a ruthless thug who thinks he can get away with it as a threat tactic to others who might want to defect to the West.
- On trade, will Europe ever get to removing tariff barriers with the US, as they have relative free trade within the EU? They should promote free and fair trade with their allies, but it may be a long struggle to get there, as the essence of a VAT tax is a built-in subsidy of foreign trade for domestic manufacturers.

# BOOK REVIEW - The Russia Hoax - by Gregg Jared

Gregg Jared, a former trial attorney and law school professor, is now a legal analyst at Fox News, but was a previous critic of Donald Trump. Yet his exhaustive research into the Hillary exoneration and latest attempts to frame Donald Trump now reveal a vast deep state conspiracy. This was to thwart legal justice and overturn a legitimate election of a Washington outsider that most in Washington never expected to win. It's a good thing Trump did get elected, so this behind the scene treachery is now revealed and not hidden forever.

Jared not only raises the issue of why Hillary should still be prosecuted, but also Obama's complicity in this conspiracy to thwart a legitimate election. One of the major conspirators, fired FBI director James Comey, is also in the legitimate crosshairs of criminal prosecution, as should many others at the top of the Obama FBI.

This conspiracy was initially uncovered after Hillary retired as Obama's Secretary of State. Freedom of Information Act Requests revealed that she conducted her entire reign at State hiding all of her emails in an illegal private server in her basement. Obama was complicit by contacting her many times using a secret name. That explains the stonewalling of many in high positions in his administration hiding the illegality, because if she got prosecuted, he was a co-conspiring enabler as well.

Enter James Comey as FBI director calling a press conference to let Hillary off the hook from clear criminal violations by using a private server that contained top secret government communications. Some could have been (and probably were) hacked by foreign enemies. Attorney General Loretta Lynch also was conflicted by a secret tarmac meeting with Bill Clinton in Phoenix a few days before the Comey press conference.

FBI co-conspirators Peter Strzok and Andrew McCabe helped to craft the exoneration speech (drafted even before Hillary's crucial interview with the FBI investigation team), changing the term "gross negligence" to "extremely careless". During Hillary's "interview" (not recorded and not sworn), one excuse was she didn't know that C meant Classified.

From a legal standpoint, intent is no excuse, as she clearly should have known that many of her never turned over 31,000 emails contained classified information. The implication of her concealing her entire email records on her private server is that she never wanted revealed the real content of her work as Secretary of State – getting donations to her Clinton Foundation. This enormous source of funds was to be the treasure trove to finance her drive to be president. Many of her overseas trips may have been for other than official state business.

For example, Russia was allowed to buy a major share of Uranium One – a Canadian corporation that got control of 20% of America's uranium ore. Hillary likely had a major role in allowing that transfer out of US control. Russia paid exorbitant fees for Bill Clinton speeches (\$225,000 to \$750,000). Russia then donated \$145 million to the Clinton foundation, with promises of more when Hillary became president. And for what services in this clear pay-

for-pay scheme? This was documented in Peter Schweizer's book: Clinton Cash: The Untold Story of How and Why Foreign Governments and Businesses Helped Make Bill and Hillary Rich. But when Hillary lost the election, this entire Clinton gravy train came crashing to a halt.

The next phase of the "beat Trump" conspiracy began almost immediately after Comey exonerated Hillary and allowed her to stay as Democratic candidate for president. The team of Trump haters led by Peter Strzok and Lisa Page, with help from Comey and his deputy director Andrew McCabe, began the behind-the-scenes dirty tricks on Trump. First they needed an excuse to spy on him and his campaign team. Enter the now famous "Dossier" of unsupported outlandish claims of Trump escapades in Russia, that were so embarrassing that Russia would supposedly have blackmail leverage over him if he ever got elected. Hillary's campaign and the DNC actually funded this story written by a former British spy David Steele, conveniently also a Trump hater.

Of equal villainy were the four FISA Court requests to spy on Trump's campaign, principally justified by this ridiculous Dossier which leading DOJ and FBI officials knew was likely bogus, and funded by Trump opponents in the upcoming election. If Rod Rosenstein ever allows release of the background sourcing, there may be criminal investigations for misleading Federal judges on the FISA court.

The amazing thing is that, despite this villainy, nothing was ever uncovered that implicates Trump or his campaign during the election that supposedly he tilted in his favor using Russian intervention. Instead Mueller used questionable practices from a vague charge allowed by Rosenstein to go after offenses committed that are totally unrelated to the election. Mueller's grand jury charges for long ago actions are likely an attempt to turn Trump associates to admit to Trump offenses, maybe even made-up ones to reduce criminal penalties.

Then there is the "insurance policy" against Trump that Strzok wanted in case the unthinkable happened – a Trump victory. One can only surmise it was the Obama loyalists setting up the collusion narrative against Trump for potential impeachment. So far that has not worked.

Sally Yates did her best at sabotage Trump as acting Attorney General, persuading newly named NSA head MIchael Flynn to meet informally with the holdover FBI. His discussions with Russians as a prelude to the new administration were characterized as clear collusion, bordering on Logan Act violations. (Not true as he was clearly acting not as a private citizen but as an early emissary to the new President. And many other administrations did similar things.)

Flynn was naïve to accept a simple FBI interview without an attorney, so he was blindsided by Yates' accusation that he would be blackmailed by Russia for lying about a meeting with Russian Ambassador Kislyak (probably wiretapped).

His weak denial on his details to VP Pence was construed as lying, especially when Sally Yates leaked all of this to the press to step up the pressure on him to resign. The sad thing is that the alleged discussions with Russians about sanctions were not unlawful, but he would have to undergo a costly legal defense, so he pleaded guilty to one count of "lying". He also felt that the government was threatening to bring his son into the case, so the easiest way out for him was a simple plea deal.

Newly named Attorney General Jeff Sessions underwent similar pressure as he left out reference to a discussion with the same Russian Ambassador Kislyak. When questioned if he talked to any Russian about campaign issues, he denied it, as his discussion with Kislyak was as a Senator, but not as a supporter of Trump. He then quickly recused himself in dealing with anything Russia as the new Attorney General. This paved the way for his new deputy Rod Rosenstein to function in his place when a Special Prosecutor was needed after James Comey was fired, alleging Obstruction of Justice by Trump.

Rosenstein should have recused himself as he was intimately involved as a witness, having written the memo suggesting that Comey be fired because of his reprehensible behavior in the Hillary exoneration.

To make matters worse, Robert Mueller should have recused himself from consideration for a variety of reasons. First, these Special Prosecutors should never come from the agencies they are to investigate. He was a former FBI director and friends with many who might be investigated. Next, the very day he was appointed by Rosenstein, he had earlier interviewed with Trump to possibly be new FBI director. Did Trump tell Mueller why he fired Comey? Also, the charge to the Special Prosecutor should have had a specific allegation of a crime that might have been committed, instead of a broad and vague charge to look into "any matters that arise."

Mueller's inherent bias is also evidenced by the immediate "team of partisans" he hired to conduct the investigation (most had contributed heavily to the Clinton campaign). Peter Strzok and Lisa Page were on it for some time before being fired, as their abject bias became well known, but Mueller did not make their firing known. Andrew Weissmann was at Hillary's headquarters the night she lost, and professed his pride at Sally Yates defying the new president in not wanting to carry out his directions. He was also famous for the "death penalty" against leading accounting firm Arthur Anderson in the Enron case, where the case was unanimously reversed (too late) in the US Supreme Court. Other team members were prominent Hillary defenders in her illegal email server or Foundation civil racketeering case.

To this day, nothing of substance has emerged from this biased Mueller team against Trump or even his campaign staff surrounding the 2016 election. So, this book by Gregg Jared remains a rather complete chronicling of the methods Hillary and Obama supporters used to try to rig an election, and subsequently overturn its results.

# Time to move on from Mueller probe (abridged)


